From South Carolina to Henry Co. Alabama, To Polk Co. Texas

William Williams, born 1800 in South Carolina and died about 1870 near Livingston, Polk County, Texas. His wife, Eliza was born in 1802 in South Carolina and she died about 1860 in Polk County. (Where buried unknown.)

Frederick Jackson Williams

Frederick Jackson served in Terry's Regiment of State Troopers in the Civil War. After the war, Frederick worked for the first railroad that was being built through Polk County. He would pick up the payroll each month and pay off the different crews of workers. One day he picked up the payroll and was in a wagon going to pay the crews and he was ambushed, shot and killed; and the payroll was stolen by the killer. The killer was never captured.

Sarah continued to live with Uncle Colonel east of Goodrich at the old home place (near the Peebles Cemetery) until her daughter, Arnetta and John T. Lowe sold their place nearby, and bought the place at Mt. Rose in 1906. When they moved and got settled, Sarah came to live with them. She was ill at the time and died in their home a short time later. She was buried in the Peebles Cemetery.
